Dear students, parents and guardians,

The principals of the secondary schools that compose Council “C” of the Archdiocese of Chicago have agreed to address together what we see as a serious problem on the South Side of Chicago. We know that many of you share this apprehension with us.

The philosophy of our schools is to provide our students with a well-rounded education within a faith community, which exhibits responsibility, demonstrates Christian service, and witnesses Gospel values, morals and attitudes.

This philosophy, which includes lessons that can be carried throughout life, includes responsible behavior at school dances.

Inappropriate dancing (juking, bumping, grinding, or of a sexual nature) is not allowed at any Council “C” High School dance, prom, or social activity. Any person or persons dancing inappropriately will incur host school’s discipline measures and may be removed from the dance.

Failure to adhere to this could result in the person or persons being removed from the dance floor and/or losing the privilege of continuing to participate at the dance and being sent home.

As responsible members of Council “C”, the dance rule will be adhered to by all Council “C” member schools. These schools will be responsible to make sure the dance rule is carried out.
